Lt Gen Sanderson's service to Australia and the region has been recognised by the award of Member of the Order of Australia (1984), Officer of the Order (1991), Companion of the Order (1994), The United States of America Legion of Merit (Commander Class) and the Grand Cross of the Royal Cambodian Order (2006). He has received honorary doctorates from a number of institutions and is Adjunct Professor at Murdoch and Griffiths Universities.
