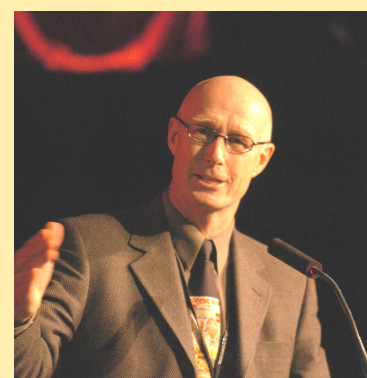

Boyd Swinburn is Professor of Population Health and Director of the World Health Organisation (WHO) Collaborating Centre for Obesity Prevention at Deakin University in Melbourne. His major research interest at Deakin University is centred on obesity prevention, particularly in children and adolescents. He has developed and supported a number of community-based demonstration projects in the Barwon-South West region of Victoria and these are linked to similar projects in Melbourne, Auckland, Fiji, and Tonga. He was President of the Australasian Society for the Study of Obesity (ASSO) from 2005-7 and has been a Steering Group member of the International Obesity Task Force (IOTF) since 1997. He has also contributed as an Expert Advisor to WHO on obesity at 15 WHO Consultations around the world since 1998. Through these efforts and his many publications and presentations, he is significantly contributing to national and global efforts to reduce the obesity epidemic.
