John is an Emeritus Fellow of the Australian National University. He was co-author of the original proposals for universal health insurance in 1968, Principal Adviser to the Whitlam and Hawke governments in the introduction of Medibank and Medicare and Chairman of the planning Committees for both schemes. He was Commissioner of the Health Insurance Commission for 16 years to mid-2000, Founding Director of the AIHW, First assistant Secretary of the Medicare Division of the Department of Health and an adviser to the governments of South Africa, Hungary, Turkey and Indonesia on health care health financing. For 15 years to 2005, he was Senior Fellow in Epidemiology and Adjunct Professor of Economics in the ANU.
