### **Martin Donohoe, MD, FACP**



Martin Donohoe is adjunct lecturer in Community Health at Portland State University and practices internal medicine with Kaiser Permanente. He serves on the Board of Advisors of Oregon Physicians for Social Responsibility (PSR) and is Chief Scientific Advisor to Oregon PSR's Campaign for Safe Foods. Martin teaches public health and has taught courses in medical humanities, social justice ethics, and the history of medicine at UCLA, UCSF, Stanford, OHSU, Clark College and Portland.

Martin will weave history, literature, and photography into a discussion of critical (but sometimes marginalized) factors affecting human health and offer specific suggestions for integrating the humanities and social sciences into health professions' education. Discussion and debate is encouraged.
